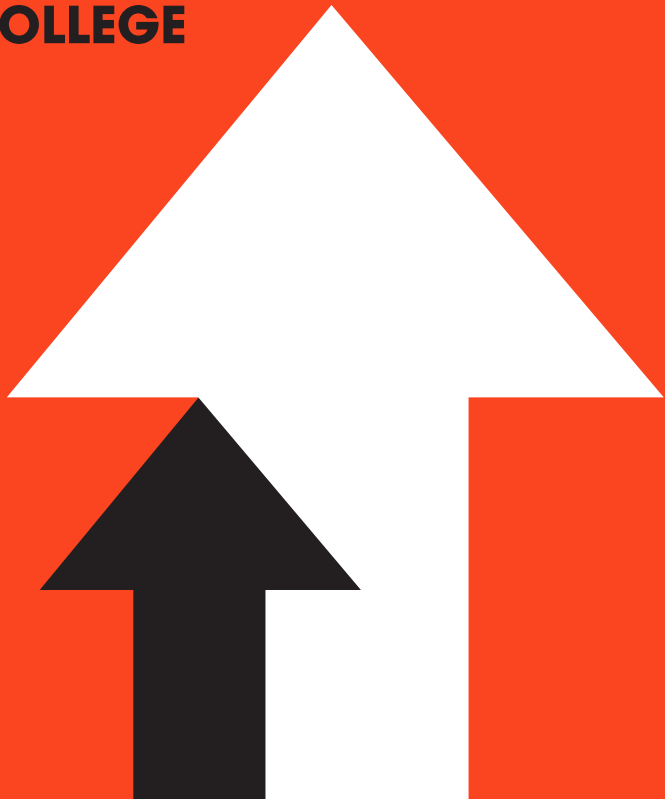

What are

T-LEVELS?

Developed alongside industry to ensure that your course meets the needs of employers, a T level is an exciting full time vocational course.

- ▶ T Levels are an alternative to A levels, apprenticeships and other 16 to 19 courses.
- ▶ Equivalent to 3 A levels, a T Level focuses on vocational skills and can help students into skilled employment, higher study, or apprenticeships.
- ▶ Each T Level includes an in-depth industry placement that lasts at least 315 hours (45 days) over two years of study.
- ▶ Students get valuable experience in the workplace; employers get early sight of the new talent in their industry.
- ▶ T Level students spend 80% of the course in the classroom, learning the skills that employers need.
- ▶ The other 20% is a meaningful industry placement, where they put these skills into action.

The overall aim of the T Level is to provide the knowledge and experience needed to open the door into skilled employment, further study or a higher apprenticeship.

T Levels we are currently delivering:

- ▶ Digital Production, Design & Development
- ▶ Education & Childcare
- ▶ Health

T levels we will deliver from September 2022:

- ▶ Business Management & Administration
- ▶ Engineering & Manufacturing

We also do a Transition to T Level programme in all the above subjects.

Digital Production, Design & Development, T Level

You will study: Software development, Digital business, Data and digital analysis, Digital environments, Emerging technology, Security.

You will be assessed through: coursework, written exams, employer set projects and your industry placement.

Progression Routes:

- Employment in software or web development
- Further study via an apprenticeship or University

Education & Childcare, T Level

You will study: Safeguarding, Health & Safety and Wellbeing, Behaviour, Parents, Families & Carers, Child Development, Observation & Assessment, Special Educational Needs & Disability

You will be assessed through: coursework, written exams, employer set projects and your industry placement.

Progression Routes:

- Employment in a nursery or school setting
- Further study via an apprenticeship or University

Health, T Level

You will study: Working within the health and science sector, Health, Safety & environmental regulations, Managing Information & Data, Good Scientific and Clinical practice, Core science concepts

You will be assessed through: coursework, written exams, employer set projects and your industry placement.

Progression Routes:

- Employment in a healthcare setting
- Further study via an apprenticeship or University
