

PAINTING

Studio Painting

This popular Studio Painting course provides further opportunity to extend your painting practice with guidance from a practising artist. In these all day sessions, you will start with group workshops, which include life drawing with a life model, exercises based on an artists work, and discussions into art theory and history. These support you as you go independently into your own painting practise in the afternoon session. The tutor will work on their own painting beside you, providing an opportunity to learn in 'real time', and will also offer helpful critique and encouragement as you need it. We end the day with a relaxed group discussion where you can receive peer feedback and gain inspiration from everyone's work. Throughout the 10 weeks, you will be able to produce a few large scale paintings or a number of smaller projects.

We will then move onto a larger work of your choice, painted over multiple weeks, in which you can bring all the knowledge learnt throughout the course. You will work from a variety of stimuli, including direct observation, photographs, and famous works of art

Printed Textiles

During this course students will explore how to create their own printed textile designs. Through original mark making, image selection and sourcing they will be guided through the processes necessary to print fabrics using various techniques. Screen print, heat press, stencils and relief among others feature. The emphasis is on self-development in a friendly group whilst becoming proficient in the use of contemporary materials that are increasingly sustainable/eco to reflect greater concern for our natural environment. Traditional dyeing and print methods alongside the inclusion of natural dyes and botanical print.

Sewing Skills

The Sewing Skills course is a practical course taught in a relaxed environment which is aimed towards building individuals confidence and independence in sewing. In part 1 you will learn basic sewing machine skills and techniques which can be applied to both clothing and textile projects. We highly recommended that you complete part 1 prior to attending part 2 where you will develop design skills and 'Fit' techniques to create a garment. Focus for part 3 is building on previous learning to extend knowledge in working on a garment from another area of the body to bring about new challenges and design/making skills.





CREATIVE FASHION

Pattern Cutting for Fashion Garments

This is a 10-week course that is designed for those interested in making their own patterns for clothing. It will help you to refine your garment construction skills taking them to the next level. You will draft your own blocks, using your own measurements. Be taught how to sew Toile's and fit them. Form these blocks you will learn how to manipulate them to creative styles of your chosen design to fit you. This term will be focused on Skirts. You will learn how to take accurate measurements for the lower part of your body to create an industrial standard block to fit yourself. With this block you will learn how to manipulate it to draft various skirt styles, from these drafts you will make a pattern of your chosen design, be taught how to sew a Toile and fit it to your body.

Creative Pattern Cutting for Fashion Garments Advanced

This is a 10-week course that is designed for those interested in making their own patterns for clothing. Learners must have completed at least 2 levels of previous Creative Pattern cutting or have experiences in pattern cutting. You will draft your own patterns using the blocks made in previous terms. It will help you to refine your garment construction skills taking them to the next level. From these blocks you will learn how to manipulate them to creative styles of your chosen design. Research various styles and produce create industrial standard patterns. You will make a pattern of your chosen design, be taught how to sew a Toile, and fit it to your body.

JEWELLERY

Jewellery

Learn essential core skills in jewellery making, to build confidence and know-how. A carefully structured series of projects will introduce you to a range of materials, techniques and processes. Returning students can choose to develop their individual design ideas. Whilst fine metalworking continues to underpin much jewellery practice, exploration of other materials, such as paper, fabric or wood, can also be considered. This 10 session programme will introduce you to skills that enable you to design and make banded rings, bangles or pendant forms. These designs will be developed from exploratory sampling, using metal wire, strip and sheet material of different weights and section. All levels of ability are welcome.

Jewellery & Silversmithing

This course is taught in our well-equipped specialist jewellery studio.

Jewellery students will be working at their own pace, to make objects such as rings, earrings, pendants, bangles and brooches. Silver-smithing students will be working at their own pace to make small objects in metal such as a bowl, box, egg-cup, night light holder, napkin ring and will learn skills such as raising metal from flat to 3D, planishing, repousse, scoring and medium scale soldering. Student learn techniques using copper or gilding metal and can buy precious metals if they wish. - The course is for all levels and beginners are welcome!

Glass Techniques




Travelling by car



From Bath

Take the A367 signposted to Radstock, stay on this road and it will bring you straight into Radstock, at the double roundabout go straight over, continue up the hill and Bath College is located on the left.

From Bristol

Join A37 signposted towards Wells. Stay on this road until you reach Farrington Gurney, at the traffic lights turn left. Continue on this road (approx 3 miles) past Tesco, straight across 3 roundabouts, follow the road past Centurion Coaches, along a sharp bend to the right; at the next roundabout turn left, continue on this road until you reach a double roundabout, turn right up the hill on the A367 (Wells Road), continue up the hill, and at the top on the left is the entrance to Bath College.

From Frome

Take the A362 into Radstock. At the first roundabout in Radstock, continue straight over, signposted towards Shepton Mallet. Turn left at the next roundabout, and continue up the hill and Bath College is located on the left.

From Shepton Mallet

Join the A37 towards Bristol, approximately 5 miles along this road, turn right onto A367 signposted to Radstock, continue along this road until you reach a roundabout, continue straight over towards Radstock, follow the road past a petrol station and police station on the right, shortly after the police station, Bath College is located on the right.

If not appropriate/acceptable a full refund of course fees will be made within fifteen days. College working days of the cancellation or the student declining the course rescheduling. In such cases the College liability shall be restricted to a reimbursement of any fees paid to the College.

In the event of cancellation of courses or classes for a reason outside the control of the College, the College shall be under no obligation to provide any reimbursement. In the event of any reimbursement being made, it shall be a gratuitous payment made without obligation or liability

2. Eligibility

You must be aged 18 or over to enrol on our Love2Learn 19+ Adult Leisure courses.

3. Attendance

If you cannot attend the first session of your course but wish to continue on the programme, you should inform the College immediately

by writing to the Student Advice Centre. If you fail to do so we reserve the right to offer your place to an applicant on our waiting list. The College reserves the right to ask a student to leave for reasons of unacceptable behaviour or gross misconduct.

4. Copyright

The copyright in all material provided by the Bath College shall (unless expressly stated or otherwise) remain vested in the College and may not be reproduced without the College's specific written consent.

The copyright in, and any work produced, by the student as part of the course, shall remain with the College and work may be retained at the discretion of the College for display or promotional activities.

5. Course content

The contents of the course are believed to be correct and to reflect the current state of the knowledge.

6. Liability and Insurance

The College shall not be liable for any loss or damage suffered by a student in connection with the provision of any course or service except in the case of death, personal injury or loss suffered as a result of the College's negligence. The College shall not be liable to the student for any delay in performing, or any failure to perform, any of the College's obligations, if the delay or failure was due to any cause beyond the College's reasonable control. The College does not insure students' personal belongings and students are responsible for making appropriate provision in respect of insurance arrangements to protect their property and person.

7. Contract

On signing the College's enrolment form the student enters into a legally binding contract with the Bath College.

8. Access to information

Information about College activities is generally available for public inspection on request. Details of documents available for inspection can be obtained from the Student Advice Centre or the Learning Centre.

9. Data Protection Act 2018

The College collects and processes information about students to make admissions decisions, to provide education and training and for administrative, health, safety and welfare and security reasons.

Some of the data about you may, because of its nature, be classified as 'Special Category Data' within the meaning of the Data Protection Act 2018. Since we cannot operate the College effectively without processing this information we need you to sign the 'Student Data Processing' clause on the enrolment form. If you do not do so we will be unable to offer you a place on a course and may withdraw any offer already made.

Financial Terms and Conditions

1. Payment terms

Settlement is due on enrolment and may be in Sterling or Euros. Places will not be held without payment. Settlement in full or in part by agreement with the College will ensure that your name appears on the course register. Attendees at classes who have not completed an enrolment will be directed to the Duty Enrolment Officer to complete the necessary enrolment documentation and to pay any fees due.

2. Interest

The College reserves the right to charge interest at the current Bank of England base rate plus 2% per month if payment is not made by the due date of payment.

3. Payee

Cheques (with a cheque guarantee card) or postal orders should be made payable to 'Bath College' and crossed 'Account payee only'. On the back should be written (in block capitals) the name and address of the student, the course title and course code.

4. Fees

All prices in respect of course fees are correct at time of going to press. In exceptional circumstances fees may be increased between publication of this prospectus and the beginning of the Academic year. In the event of an increase, students will be notified accordingly. Students not wishing to pursue courses at the increased fee must notify the College in writing within fourteen days of receiving notice of the increase and the College shall reimburse all monies already paid.

5. Withdrawal from course

All fees agreed on enrolment will be due regardless of whether a student later withdraws voluntarily from the course.

6. Exam fee

A charge will be made for exam fees

where a student fails to sit an exam which forms part of the Learning Agreement and for which the College has paid.

7. Reimbursement

Once enrolled, a student is liable for the fee identified in this agreement regardless of whether they subsequently decide to withdraw from the course. Reimbursement in whole or in part for fees paid will only be considered in truly exceptional cases, subject to clause 1 of the Student Registration/Enrolment conditions.

All applications for reimbursement should be made in writing to the Finance Office. Appropriate supporting documentation must be attached (e.g. medical certificates). The College reserves the right to make a deduction of $\mathfrak{L}25$ or 15% (which ever is the greater) from such reimbursements to represent the administration and other cost to the College occasioned by the student's withdrawal.

If the College requires a student to leave for reasons of conduct, the student will remain liable for the whole amount agreed at enrolment. Any reimbursement approved by the Principal will be made within fifteen College working days of the date of receipt of the application for such reimbursement. Full reimbursement will be made within fourteen College working days where courses are cancelled by the College.

8. Course transfers

Any student who is enrolled on a course and wishes to transfer to a different course should put their request to their tutor. The decision will be made by the relevant Head of Department. There will be no refunds for courses at a lower fee and any increase in fee will be payable by the student.

9. Credit notes

Credit notes in whole or in part may be obtained for course withdrawal for reasons agreed between the student and the College which are not covered in the reimbursement criteria above. Credit notes may be valid for a one year period from the date of issue and are not transferable subject to the College's discretion. Students should apply in writing for a credit note.

10. Fee reductions

Fee reductions will only be applicable to courses as indicated in this prospectus and to students meeting the criteria as laid down in this prospectus. Evidence must be provided on College form CO25.

11. Receipts

Receipts will be provided for all monies paid to the College except where payment is made through BACS or standing order.

12. Non acceptance of applicants

The College reserves the right not to accept applicants or enrolments from individuals or sponsors where fees or other costs from previous courses remain outstanding until such time as all outstanding fees or other outstanding costs are paid.

13. Non payment of fees

In addition to the terms of clause 12 above, the College reserves the right to terminate an enrolment at any time during the life of a course where fees are outstanding or where any agreed instalment payment defaults. In the event of the College exercising the right to terminate an enrolment, the person concerned has a right of appeal under the terms of the College Appeals Procedure, available from the Student Advice Centre.

The College may take legal action for the recovery of monies due and in such circumstances the College reserves the right to make charges of up to $\mathfrak{L}250$ to represent the administration and other costs to the College occasioned by the non-payment.
