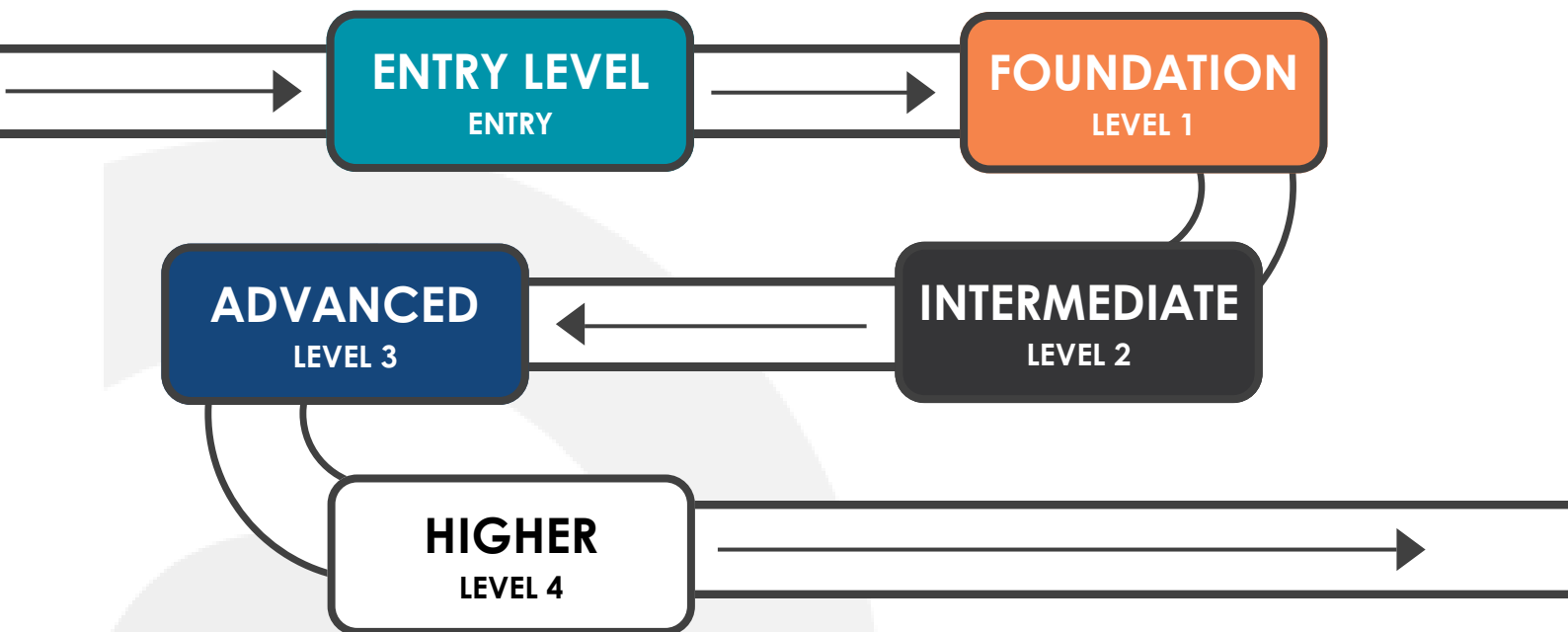

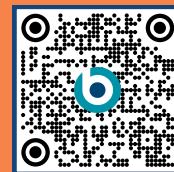

UCAS Tariff Points Explained

UCAS Tariff points translate your qualifications and grades into a numerical value. Many qualifications (but not all) have a UCAS Tariff value, which will vary dependent on the qualification size, and the grade you achieved. This numerical value is used by HE course providers to assess whether you meet their entry requirements for a particular course. This guide helps you translate BTEC Level 3 and T Levels into their A Level equivalent grade.
